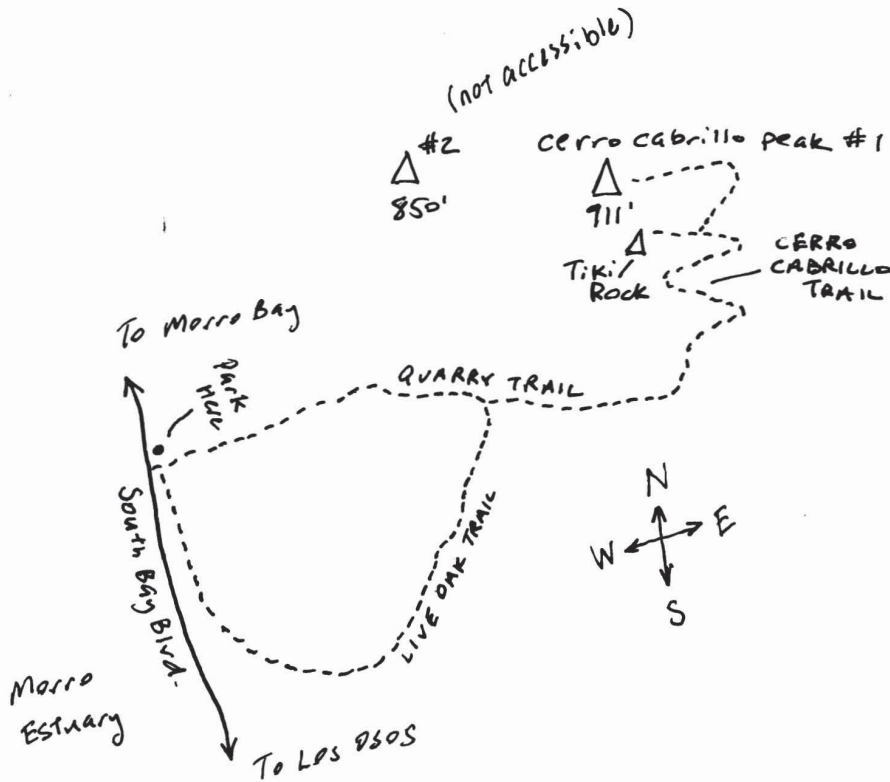


4. Cerro Cabrillo Peak



Driving Directions:

From Los Osos take South Bay Boulevard toward Morro Bay. Turn right into the trailhead parking lot, which you will see across the street from the Morro Estuary.

From Highway 1, exit Los Osos/Baywood Park at the Morro Bay City limits. Drive about 1.5 miles from that point toward Los Osos. Look for the parking lot on the left hand side, across the street from the Morro Estuary.

Hiking Directions:

You are going to start off on the path marked "Quarry Trail" heading east up a scrubby slope. You are going to keep bearing that same direction until you will hang a left on the Cerro Cabrillo Trail. On that path you will have the option to check out Tiki Rock, in which case you will backtrack and then continue to the taller of the two peaks on Cerro Cabrillo (you cannot access peak #2 by trail). Enjoy the view!

NOTE – There is a little bit of "rock hoppin'" involved at these peaks. Just be careful and make sure you have sure footing at all times... lots of crumbling rocks.

On your way back down, you add a change of scenery by taking the Live Oak Trail, which will loop you back to the original trailhead. Essentially, this trail wraps around the base of Portola Point and lengthens the walk a bit. Depending on the season, you may be treated to some incredible wildflowers!
